# Executive Vice President's Message



After each legislative session Montana Farm Bureau issues our Legislative Report Card to provide our members with a comprehensive look at the voting record of Montana Legislators based on the bills on which we took a position. We are proud to provide the following Report Card for the 69th Montana Legislative Session.

For this version of the report we have included most of the bills supported or opposed by MFBF that saw a floor vote. We believe that reduces the level of subjectivity. It's important to note that an individual voting record does not tell the entire story of a legislator's support for Montana agriculture. For instance, you will notice that report card grades were lower than in prior sessions. One reason is that Montana Farm Bureau had many important supporters on tax legislation who didn't vote our way on water-related bills and alternatively, we had legislators supporting Farm Bureau policy on water-related legislation who did not vote with us on tax issue. That does not discount their support to agriculture.

Agriculture is Montana's largest industry and there are many issues addressed during the session that have a profound effect on our farmers and ranchers. We need to thank our 150 citizen legislators for their service to the state of Montana. Whether we agree or disagree on an issue, they spend a great deal of time away from their homes and jobs in order to represent the interests of their constituents.

I want to extend my respect and gratitude to our Montana Farm Bureau Legislative Team, Nicole Rolf, Karli Johnson and Sage Zook. Nicole and Karli are well-respected lobbyists in Helena where they represent our organization and the agricultural industry with dignity and professionalism. Sage's role behind the scenes was instrumental in the organization of our efforts and she should be proud of her contribution. I would also like to acknowledge the great work from all of our staff for their expert organization of our legislative visits and events, for providing our members with resources that keep them up to date with our efforts in Helena and for activating our Montana grassroots in support of our legislative efforts.

# Legislative Report Card Scoring Methodology

Each bill included in the report card is weighted by a factor of 5, 10, or 15 based on its importance to Montana's agricultural industry and relevance to MFBF policy.

## Floor Votes:

Scores for floor votes are assigned a value of 1-4 based on the percentage of legislators who voted in favor of the MFBF position. If more than 90% of legislators vote "yes" on a bill that MFBF supports, it is awarded 1 point. If 75% or more of the vote is in favor of our position the bill is awarded 2 points, for votes of 50% or more 3 points are awarded and for votes where 50% or fewer legislators voted in our favor 4 points are given. Zero points are given for votes against the MFBF position. This is based on the last vote that the bill received on the floor.

### **Example:**

*MFBF supported SB/HB XXX and its weighted score was 10 points. More than 75% of legislators supported our position and voted 'yes' which resulted in 2 points being awarded for this vote. Based on the assigned score and the additional weighted amount, this vote is worth 12 pts. Senators who vote our position on this bill receive 12 pts while senators who opposed MFBF receive zero points.*

## Sponsorship Points:

Legislators sponsoring bills MFBF supports will receive additional points commensurate with the weighted factor of the bill (5, 10, or 15). Legislators sponsoring bills MFBF opposes will lose the number of points commensurate with the weighted factor of the bill (5, 10, or 15).

**\*Note\*** *When a legislator is absent or excused that vote is not taken out of their overall total.*

# Agriculture's Legislative Award Winners

## Outstanding Friend of Farm Bureau Award Winner

*This award is given to the Senator or Representative who had one of the highest scores overall on MFBF's legislative scorecard; this legislator demonstrated their support of Montana agriculture through their voting record, bill sponsorship and leadership within various committees.*



### **Representative Ken Walsh (R) HD 69, Twin Bridges**

Representative Walsh voted with Farm Bureau nearly 100% of the time and carried multiple bills that Farm Bureau supported. Rep. Walsh hails from an agriculture heavy district and comes from an agriculture background, giving him excellent knowledge of issues important to farmers and ranchers. Even while serving in the House Appropriations Committee, a committee that requires distinct attention to the state budget, he carried several big pieces of legislation important to senior water right holders, and was always willing to help out on agriculture policy issues. While we missed him on the Natural Resources and Agriculture Committees he served on last year, his extensive finance and agriculture knowledge served him and our industry well in the Appropriations world.

## Distinguished Service Golden Plow Award Winner

*This award is given to a termed-out legislator who has exhibited exemplary service and dedication to agriculture in their tenure as a legislator.*



### **Senator Bruce "Butch" Gillespie (R) SD 9, Ethridge**

Senator Gillespie completed his second term as a state senator this session. As a rancher and Farm Bureau member himself, it is not surprising that he exemplified the agriculture spirit throughout his legislative service. Senator Gillespie served as the Senate Agriculture, Livestock, and Irrigation Committee Chairman, striving successfully to make it a welcoming, educational, and collaborative committee for not just members, but also any lobbyist or member of the public who set foot in the room. # Montana Farm Bureau's Priority Bill Summaries

## *Improving and Protecting Montana Agriculture*

---

### **HB 80: Provide cash lease-only bidding for ag leases. Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Randyn Gregg (R) HD 78, White Sulphur Springs*

This bill requires cash leasing in the competitive bidding process for state agriculture land leases, removing the complicated crop share process in existing law. This simplifies the process for the DNRC and Montana farmers, alike. It allows for continued crop-share leases on renewals if there are no competitive bids. This bill was broadly supported and signed into law.

### **HB 119: Establish a Montana Cattle Committee. Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Brandon Ler (R) HD 33, Savage*

This bill was the result of nearly three years of negotiation and discussion by the Montana Cattle Committee, a loosely affiliated group of Montana ranchers from a wide range of agriculture organizations who came together to work out the particulars of how a Montana Beef Checkoff should be structured, how it would be appointed, and how it would promote Montana beef and cattle genetics in Montana and beyond. The legislation provided the legal process to establish a Montana Cattle Commodity Committee which would have been a promotional committee within the Department of Livestock. MFBF passed policy during our 2024 Annual Convention to support this effort and worked diligently to see this legislation through, even crafting amendments to satisfy concerns from the Governor's office and other organizations. It is important to note that this legislation also set up a referendum process which would have required an opportunity for ranchers to vote in favor of the new assessment before its establishment. Unfortunately, it drew a great deal of opposition from ranchers and organizations who believed it would not provide fair representation, a beneficial outcome, and who did not understand that a referendum would be required before implementation. It ultimately died in the Senate Agriculture Committee, in favor of an interim study to work through some unresolved questions.

### **HJ 52: Interim study on the Montana cattle industry. Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Eric Tilleman (R) HD 23, Great Falls*

After the demise of HB 119, MFBF requested a study resolution to explore the creation of a Montana Beef/Cattle Promotion Committee. This interim study will seek to answer some of the critical questions that came up during hearings on HB 119 and feedback that legislators had been receiving from their constituents. It passed the legislature and now awaits assignment to an interim committee.

### **HB 130: Revise state wildland fire policy and funding. Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Llew Jones (R) HD 18, Conrad*

This bill allows DNRC to respond to any fires within five miles of state land or critical infrastructure, providing more aggressive initial attack and more effective wildland fire control. It was signed into law.

### **HB 197: Revising workers' compensation laws relating to when the employee is released to return to work. Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Anthony Nicastro (R) HD 50, Billings*

This bill streamlines the process for injured workers to return to work after an injury and removes burdensome requirements, making it easier for people to get back to work after a worker's compensation claim. This pro-business legislation was signed into law.

### **SB 80: Allow for digital copies of required documentation for transport of livestock. Support**

*Sponsored by Sen. Josh Kassmier (R) SD 13, Fort Benton*

This bill allows for digital copies of trip and market consignment permits for livestock as opposed to the former requirement for paper copies of these documents, providing for the modernization of an essential process protecting animal health in this state, as well as more efficiencies for livestock haulers. The legislation was requested by the Department of Livestock and was signed into law.

**SB 320: Create Montana-Ireland trade commission. Support**

*Sponsored by Sen. Mike Cuffe (R) SD 1, Eureka*

Trade is essential to Montana farmers and ranchers because it allows us better access to markets in which to sell our products, adding value at the farm gate. While new trade agreements on the federal level have ground to a halt on the federal level, Montana stepped up to the plate to foster new trade relationships with a county near and dear to many of our hearts. SB 320 creates an Ireland Trade Commission with a mission of expanding diplomatic relations with the country, and trade for all Montana industries including Montana agriculture. It was signed into law on St. Patrick's Day.

**SB 415: Generally revise milk laws. Oppose**

*Sponsored by Sen. Greg Hertz (R) SD 7, Polson*

This bill would have changed the 12-day milk rule, under which Montana dairy producers and retailers operate today. Also known as the "Sell By Date," milk must be labeled with an earlier date telling stores when milk must be sold, leaving more freshness on the shelves of consumers. This bill would have replaced the sell by date with a "Best by" date, allowing stores to hold milk toward the end of its freshness and reducing shelf life for consumers. It was tabled in the Senate Public Health Committee. A blast motion was attempted but it failed. We scored this bill based on how Senators voted on the blast motion.

## *Funding for critical programs*

---

**HB 357: Provide funding for middle school career and technical education. Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Eric Tilleman (R) HD 23, Great Falls*

HB 357 provides additional funding for middle school career and technical education. This created a grant to match federal funding making it more worthwhile for small schools to apply to fund programs such as FFA. It was signed into law.

**HB 860: Provide for veterinary training loan program. Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Randyn Gregg (R) HD 78, White Sulphur Springs*

This bill would have created a veterinary training loan program, based on a successful model used in Kansas. This funding would help improve access to rural veterinarians by providing grants and loans to students that choose to practice in underserved areas in the large animal field. The bill was vetoed due to its cost to the general fund.

**SB 167: Provide funding for noxious weed trust. Support**

*Sponsored by Sen. Greg Hertz (R) SD 7, Polson*

SB 167 would have provided an additional \$10 million in funding to the existing noxious weed trust fund, resulting in more grant funding to counties for use in noxious weed control. Even though it was included in the Governor's original budget, it ended up being vetoed due to its impact on the general fund.

## *Wildlife, Predators and Access*

---

**HB 354: Revise penalties for criminal trespass while fishing, trapping, hunting, or collecting antlers/sheds/horns. Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Jill Cohenour (D) HD 83, Helena*

This bill allows hunting and fishing licenses to be revoked for up to two years for those convicted of criminal trespass while in the act of shed hunting, in addition to hunting and fishing. Current fines are often not a deterrent for trespassers, especially those that are engaging in lucrative shed hunting so passage and subsequent signing of this bill is a big victory for private property rights and landowners seeking to protect their farms and ranches.

**HB 356: Allow livestock loss reimbursement for black bear predation. Support**

*Sponsored by Eric Tilleman (R) HD 23, Great Falls*

During their annual meeting last September, Cascade County Farm Bureau requested that MFBF pursue legislation adding black bear predation to the Livestock Loss Reduction and Mitigation Program, which is exactly what HB 356 does. This bill allows Livestock Loss Board reimbursement for black bear predation on covered livestock for which the owners have paid per capita. It was carefully crafted to not require additional funding from the general fund, while leaving plenty of money available to reimburse ranchers who have sustained losses from previously included predators: wolves, grizzly bears, and mountain lions. This legislation was widely supported by agriculture and conservation organizations, saw little resistance through the process, and passed the legislature. MFBF followed up with a signature request letter and was pleased that the Governor signed the bill.

## Water

---

### **HB 504: Expand livestock loss eligibility to include domestic bison. Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Eric Tilleman (R) HD 23, Great Falls*

Inspired by our bill to add a predator to the Livestock Loss Reduction and Mitigation Program, this bill allows domestic bison to be eligible for reimbursement by the Livestock Loss Board for confirmed predator losses. MFBF policy supports inclusion of all livestock that pay per capita into the program and this was signed into law.

### **HB 648: Require FWP notification before the release of large predators. Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Brandon Ler (R) HD 33, Savage*

This bill requires FWP to notify local county commissioners and sheriffs before the release of large predators, creating a more transparent process for wildlife management. MFBF worked to get some amendments in the House and were then happy to support this bill through the rest of the process. We have long sought this type of legislation so we were pleased to see it finally pass and be signed into law.

### **HB 767: Revise county predator control laws to include goats. Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Julie Darling (R) HD 84, Helena*

HB 767 allows goat producers to create county predator petitions like cattle and sheep producers can. The former law did not allow such an action for goats and as more ranchers have started raising the species, this bill was a simple update to allow optional predator assessments to control predators and protect livestock. It was signed into law.

### **SB 441: Establishing the block management enforcement network. Support**

*Sponsored by Denly Loge (R) SD 45, St Regis*

This “sunshine” bill creates a process for landowners enrolled in Block Management to share information about bad actors across properties, giving landowners better information and control over who they allow on their property for hunting. It was signed into law.

### **HB 676: Generally revise state land and water law. Oppose**

*Sponsored by Rep. Brandon Ler (R) HD 33, Savage*

As originally introduced, this bill stripped the water court of its duties, making it nearly impossible for them to accomplish their task of final adjudication. It also set an arbitrary date for them to complete this work, then turned over the process to the District Court which would have jeopardized the adjudication process and violated the McCarren Amendment. It further required the sale of any state land with a water right to the lessee, forgoing the normal competitive bidding process that protects the state school trust. It also required that for the State to obtain a water right on their land, both the place of use and place of diversion must exist on state land. Even after significant amendments in the Senate, the legislation was deemed unconstitutional and vetoed by the Governor.

### **HB 704: Generally revise ground water laws. Oppose**

*Sponsored by Rep. Mike Vinton (R) HD 40, Billings*

The “worst” of the exempt well bills this session, HB 704 threw out nearly all protections for other water right holders by essentially making the only requirement to drill an exempt well to be the physical availability of water, regardless of legal availability. It would have prohibited the DNRC from stopping further exempt wells until significant and expensive study was conducted. The bill died on second reading on the House floor.

### **HB 775: Repeal sunset on Water Court actions. Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Ken Walsh (R) HD 69, Twin Bridges*

This bill simply repealed the sunset on Water Court actions. MFBF supported this bill as it ensures the water court will exist to finish adjudication and it was signed into law.

### **HB 886: Provide for water division court judges. Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Ken Walsh (R) HD 69, Twin Bridges*

Taking the future of the Water Court a step further than HB 775, this Comprehensive Water Review bill created a process for the continuation of the divisional water court post final adjudication to deal with

future disputes and controversial matters in a timely and appropriate manner. Unfortunately, there are still some bumps to smooth out in this process and the bill ultimately died on the House floor after being blasted out of committee.

**SB 186: Provide for expedited processing in district courts of water cases arising under final decree. **Oppose****

*Sponsored by Sen. Barry Usher (R) SD 19, Billings*

SB 186 dissolved the water court post adjudication and created a process to expedite water cases in district court by allowing cases to be heard by authorized agents rather than judges. It failed second reading on the Senate floor.

**SB 358: Revise exempt water rights laws. **Oppose****

*Sponsored by Sen. Wylie Galt (R) SD 39, Martinsdale*

This bill came out of the Comprehensive Water Review process and purported to be a “compromise” bill on a controversial subject. MFBF opposed the bill coming out of the Comprehensive Water Review but worked diligently to amend the legislation in ways that would have protected existing water right holders. As introduced, the bill curtailed the use of new exempt wells in small, overdeveloped areas but expanded the exemption in the majority of the state. It was further amended to authorize DNRC to use aerial surveillance for enforcement and stripped protections for water quality, as well as removing one of the closure areas, disregarding the science behind the concept. MFBF’s proposed amendments that would have curtailed exempt well usage in areas approaching overdevelopment and protected the resource and our property rights were rejected. Ultimately, most of the amendments that were added made a bad bill even worse and it ended up going down in flames by a vote of 14-36 on the Senate floor.

## *Taxes*

---

**HB 155: Revise class four residential and commercial property taxes. **Oppose****

*Sponsored by Rep. Mark Thane (D) HD 89, Missoula*

This bill endeavored to provide residential property tax relief. It lowered the tax rate on residential property and introduced a progressive property tax system, creating a tax shift to agriculture, as well as other property types. After making it through the House, it died in the Senate before being partially rolled into SB 542.

**HB 411: Exempt agricultural property from open space levies.**

**Support**

*Sponsored by Rep. Jane Gillette (R) HD 77, Three Forks*

This bill simply exempted agricultural property from open space levies and was signed into law.

**SB 323: Revise individual income tax rates and earned income.**

**Support**

*Sponsored by Sen. Josh Kassmier (R) SD 13, Fort Benton*

Considered to be the Governor’s Income Tax Reduction bill, it lowered income tax rates from 5.9% to 4.9% in tax year 2027, and reduced the capital gains tax from 4.1% to 3.9% in tax year 2026. It also expanded the Earned Income Tax from 10 to 15% of the federal credit. It was tabled in the Senate Taxation Committee. A blast motion was attempted but it failed. We scored this bill based on how Senators voted on the blast motion.

**SB 542: Generally revise property tax laws. **Oppose****

*Sponsored by Sen. Wylie Galt (R) SD 39, Martinsdale*

Starting out as a proposal to freeze property values for two years, MFBF did not initially have a position on this bill. However, it was ultimately amended to incorporate concepts from HB 155 and HB 231 and became the final vehicle for residential property tax relief. In its final version, the bill reduces the taxes on owner-occupied homes and some small businesses but raised the taxes on second homes, short-term rentals, large commercial properties, and shifts the tax burden to other types of property in most locations. It also introduces the concept of progressivity to the property tax system, meaning the tax rate increases with the value of the property. Furthermore, homes on agriculture land are treated differently than those that are not and some will pay a higher tax rate. Even though the bill reduces the tax rate slightly on Class 3 property (agriculture land), our rate becomes relatively much higher than the former law compared to residential property. This massive change to the property tax system will most definitely provide relief to primary homes, but it does so by shifting the burden onto other types of property including agriculture land, which MFBF opposes. Our only major loss of the year, this bill passed and was signed by the Governor.
